

CREATE A FLAG LINE

PATTERN



SUPPLIES:

- Biais tape
- Cotton fabric
- Tailor's chalk
- Scissors
- Pins
- Sewing Machine or needle and thread



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STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

STEP 1: Drawing the pattern on the fabric

Draw the pattern on the backside of the cotton fabric with a tailor's chalk.
Make as much as you like.

Tip: Folding the fabric will ensure you'll end up with an even number.

STEP 2: Cutting the fabric

Make sure you have an even number, so you will have a front and backside for each of your flags.

STEP 3: Pinning the sides

Pin the front to the backside, making sure you display the 'good' sides.

STEP 4: Sew the outline

Sew the stitch lines of the flags, leaving 1 centimeter space from the sides.
The top side is left open.

STEP 5: Turn inside out

Turn the flags inside out, displaying the 'good' side. Use the point of your scissors to turn the pointy end of the flag inside out correctly. Pin the flags.

STEP 6: Quilting the stitch

Quilt the stitch with a 2 millimeter space from the edge of the flags, making the flags nice and flat. Ironing the flags could help as well.

STEP 7: Attaching flags to biais tape

Fold the biais tape open and lay the 'good' side of the tape on the backside of your flags. Attach all your flags to the tape and determine a nice and even distribution of the flags. Keep in mind to leave a 30 centimeters space at both ends of the tape to hang your flag banner properly and pin your flags to the tape to ensure their place during stitching. Fold the tape and stitch the tape at 1 millimeter from the edge.
